Modelled on the Climate Fresk

- an educational card game with over a million followers the Book Fresk is designed to raise awareness of sustainable development isues among book professionals.

Created in 2023 by Fontaine O Livres and CSR specialist Charles Hédouin, the Book Fresk is an educational tool presented as a colaborative workshop built around a card game. The information presented draws on the latest data from the sector (SNE, ADEME, The Shift Project, etc...), to propose actionable goals.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Professionials in the book sector who are learning about or already aware of the issues surrunding climate change an sustainable development.

HOW THE BOOK FRESK WORKS?

Face-to-face

15 players maximum (3 teams made up of 5 people)

Brainstorming - 1h

Working with the facilitator, participants receive a deck of cards presenting the various actors incolved in the value chain of the book industry. The object of the game is to work together to place the cards on the table in the right order. Once all the cards have been laid out, participants draw the links connecting each card with the next in the chain.

Search for solutions - 1h

Once the cards are in place to illustrate the book value chain, each team determines specific solutions that falls under their scope of action. The teams must then rank the different solutions based on effectiveness and roll-out potential.

Discussion & outlook - 1h

For the last hour, each team presents their solutions and actionable goals to the other tables. The facilitator intervenes in the discussions as an advisor to help participants scale solutions to their own level.
